

ATIPPA Review Committee – Notice of Public Hearings

The ATIPPA Review Committee will hold its first public hearings in St. John's, NL, on June 24, 25, and 26, 2014. The hearings will start each day at 10:00 a.m. and will be held at the Ramada Inn, 102 Kenmount Road.

The hearings are open to the public and will also be webcast on the Committee's website at www.parcnl.ca.

On the first day of hearings, the Committee will hear from the Information and Privacy Commissioner Ed Ring and an official from his office. In the days leading up to public hearings, a complete list of other participants who will be presenting will be posted on the Committee's website.

The Review Committee was established by the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador to conduct an independent statutory review of the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (ATIPPA), including an examination of the amendments made through Bill 29.
