### ATIPPA Review Begins Online Consultations

The committee reviewing the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act (ATIPPA) will begin online consultations, starting Friday, July 11. The online consultations are in addition to formal written submissions, and to the public hearings that are currently underway.

“The committee wants to hear from as many people as possible,” said committee chair Clyde Wells. “Online consultations will open up the process to people who don’t wish to do formal written or oral presentations.”

Starting Friday, July 11, the Committee will introduce aspects of the ATIPPA on its website, including questions that people can address. The schedule is listed below:
